WHAT is the Family Fun Festival?

WAU's Family Fun Festival is a locally established tradition, and has provided wholesome entertainment to the community for over a decade.

This year, WAU's Family Fun Festival will be held on **Sunday, April 13, 2014** from 12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. rain or shine.
