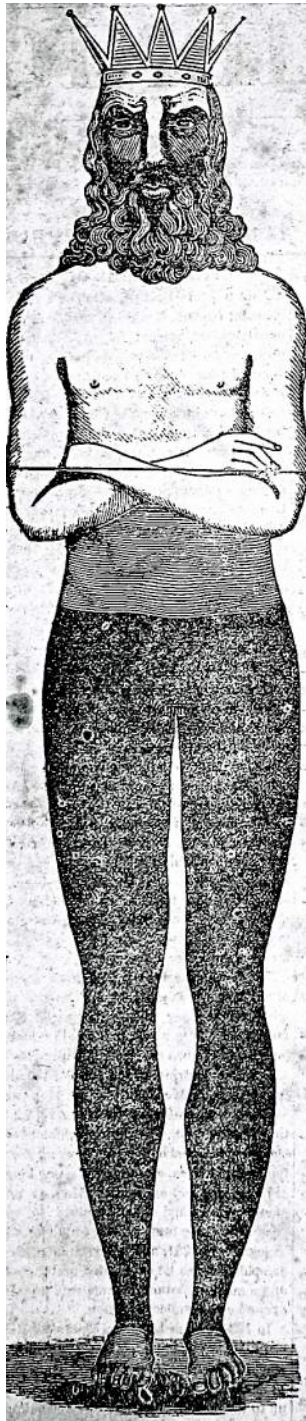




The WAU Department of Religion & the WAU Honors Program present:
