- Permission of the academic department chair is required for enrollment as a guest graduate student.
- Guest graduate student status is granted for one semester. If a student wishes to enroll in additional graduate courses, he or she will need to submit a new guest student application each semester.

- Proof of baccalaureate degree completion as evidence by official transcripts from a regionally accredited institution (or the international equivalent) is required. An exception may be made during the student's first semester of enrollment as a guest graduate student, but in no case will the student be allowed to enroll in additional courses without evidence of baccalaureate degree completion.

Terms and Conditions

- All policies regarding course pre-requisites apply to guest graduate students, unless a specific written exception is made by the chair of the academic department.
- Enrollment as a guest student does not guarantee admission into any of Washington Adventist University's graduate programs.
- A maximum of 9 credits taken while enrolled as a guest graduate student may be applied toward a Washington Adventist University degree.
- Financial aid is not available to guest graduate students.
- Tuition and fees for special courses and seminars are as announced by the coordinator of such programs. Payment must be made in full at the Accounting Office or SGPs Business Manager's Office.
- Admission is granted without regard to race, sex, handicap, or national origin, but is based on academic qualification. WAU expects every student to adhere to and respect the principles and regulations of WAU and the standards of the Seventh-day Adventist Church. The student is responsible for learning these principles and regulations, which can be found in the student handbook.
