Individual exceptions to the examination schedule may be granted by the instructor ***prior to exam week*** for the following reasons:

1. Death in the immediate family.
2. Documented medical emergency demanding immediate attention.
3. An examination schedule with three or more examinations in one day.

NOTE: All travel, weddings, work, medical appointments, and other arrangements should be made early to avoid conflict with the examination schedule. If permission is granted for a special examination, the student will be expected to pay a fee to cover the cost of preparing and proctoring the examination. The fee may vary from \$25 to \$50 for each examination according to the course requirements and will be payable in cash.
