DO NOT put holes (using a hammer) in the wall(s) unless approved by Facilities Services

- ✚ Storage bins
- ✚ Full-length mirror (optional)
- ✚ Plants or LED lights

- ✚ Dryer Sheets
- ✚ Fabric Softener
- ✚ Automatic Shut Off Iron
- ✚ Money for Laundry Card
- ✚ Laundry Bag/ Collapsible Hamper
- ✚ Laundry Detergent

Cleaning

- ✚ Broom and Dust Pan
- ✚ Garbage Bags
- ✚ Small Garbage Can
- ✚ Lysol
- ✚ Paper Towels
- ✚ Sponges
- ✚ Dish Detergent
- ✚ Windex
- ✚ Swiffer
- ✚ Clorox Wipes
- ✚ Disinfectant Spray/ Wipes

- ✚ Can Opener

Computer and Electronics

- ✚ Batteries
- ✚ Cell Phone
- ✚ Cell Phone Charger
- ✚ Clock
- ✚ Desk Lamp
- ✚ Flashlight
- ✚ Extension cords/power strips
- ✚ Portable charger

DO NOT BRING

- ✚ Candles
- ✚ Hot plates/toasters
- ✚ Expensive valuables (*STRONGLY SUGGESTED*)
- ✚ Large furniture without approval
- ✚ No full-size refrigerators
- ✚ No separate large freezers
